

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Can I use a tree stand?**
Only those portable types that are not inserted into the tree and do not damage the tree. They can be put up on November 17, 2017 and must be removed by December 10, 2017.
- 2. Will there be permits available at the Filtration Plant?**
No.
- 3. Do we enforce the need for a permit and rules?**
YES! We will be patrolling and asking to see 2017 WMWA permits and PA 2017 hunting licenses. Persons without permit and license on their person or violating the WMWA permit rules or PA Game Laws will be arrested for trespassing.
- 4. Where can we park and when? Where can we hunt?**
On permitted hunting days only, parking will be permitted along Sulfur Springs Road, Jacks Hollow Road and in special parking lots just west of the Filtration Plant. See WMWA Hunting Map for hunting areas and restricted areas. For the purpose of scouting prior to permitted hunting days, all visitors must sign in at the Mosquito Valley Visitor Parking Lot near the Filtration Plant.
- 5. Can we access the watershed from the end of Sunnyside Road?**
Yes, But **ONLY** on the designated hunting days November 18, 27, 28, 29, 30, December 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, 2017. Anyone wishing to scout this area must first sign in at the Mosquito Valley Road Visitor Parking Lot at the end of Mosquito Valley Road and then access this area from Route 44.
- 6. Can we access the watershed from surrounding private land?**
Yes, but only with permission from the landowner. On non-hunting days you must sign in at the Mosquito Valley Visitor Parking Lot near the Filtration Plant; on permitted hunting days you must have a 2017 WMWA hunting permit and 2017 Hunting License.
- 7. Can I walk through a posted restricted area during the hunt?**
No, they are off limits at all times.
- 8. How early can we go into the WMWA watershed on permitted hunting days?**
Generally as early as you wish, however, no earlier than 4:30 AM at the Mosquito Valley Filtration Plant access and you must be out by 6:00 PM.
- 9. Will you help me get my deer out?**
Be prepared to remove your deer out to your car as you would on State Game or Forest Land.
- 10. Are there limits to the number of permits and when they can be issued?**
No. They will be available at the WMWA business office through December 8, 2017 and on the internet through December 9, 2017.
- 11. What about handicapped hunters?**
Anyone wishing special handicapped consideration must first hold a State Game Commission Disabled Person and may call the WMWA Plant Superintendent at (570) 323-8608 to discuss accommodations which may include hunting from a vehicle along Route 554 or near parking areas. Those individuals who are only assisting disabled hunters must have a 2017 WMWA permit.
- 12. When will the WMWA watershed be open to the public this fall?**
It is open sunrise to sunset in accordance with posted visitor use rules except during permitted hunting days when only valid 2017 WMWA permit holders with valid 2017 Pa Hunting Licenses may be on the WMWA watershed property. Permitted hunting dates are November 18, 27, 28, 29, 30, December 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, 2017.
- 13. Can I use my DMAP antlerless license on November 27, 2017?**
Yes, but only the DMAP unit identification #2078 issued by the WMWA for this area and you must also have a valid 2017 WMWA permit and a valid 2017 Pa Hunting License.
